Mark your calendars – May 15-16, 2026 – for the Loomis Quilt & Fiber Guild's 8th quilt show. Our theme this year is "Reflections in the Garden."

The quilt show will be located at the First United Methodist Church, 6416 Brace Road, Loomis. The "Garden Boutique" and vendors will be located at the church as well.

Attached you will find the Entry Instructions, Entry Forms, Claim Check as well as directions to make a sleeve. Deadline for entries is April 15, 2026. Please complete one Entry Form for each item.

As in our previous Quilt Shows, we will let our viewers do the judging. Awards will be given for the following categories: **\*Note the new number designations for each category.**

- 100- Challenge 2026
- 200 - Pieced Large (not to exceed 98" x 106" or 408 inches overall)
- 300 - Pieced Medium (not to exceed 80" x 94" or 348 inches overall)
- 400 - Pieced Small (not to exceed 48" x 66" or 228 inches overall)
- 500- Modern
- 600 - Applique
- 700 - Hand/Machine Embroidered
- 800 - Artistic (Original Design)
- 900 - Wall Hangings (not to exceed 48" x 36")
- 1000 - Miniatures (not to exceed 24" x 24")
- 1100 - Home Accessory – dolls; table runners; bed runners; placemats; napkins; potholders; etc.
- 1200 - Wearable Art – purses; scarves; clothing (quilted, knitted or crochet) and other fiber arts
- 1300 - Youth

Entry Instructions

**Entry Deadline: April 15, 2026**

**ENTRY RULES:** LQ&FG members may enter as many items as you would like to have shown. There will be no professional judges; however, there will be a Viewer's Choice Award. Our objective is to allow our members to show as many quilts as they wish. However, LQ&FG reserves (1) The right to limit the number of entries for a category due to space availability; & (2) the right to change an entry to a different category due to lack of entries for the requested category. \*\*Note: Please remember that quilts that been shown at any of our previous shows should not be submitted. For each entry, send a copy of the entry form and a photo of each item (or a picture of the pattern) to Carolyn Landers PO Box 1387 Lincoln, CA 95648. **AWARDS AND RIBBONS** –The Viewer's Choice Award (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and HM) will be given in the following categories:

- 100 - Challenge 2026
- 200 - Pieced Large
- 300 - Pieced Medium
- 400 - Pieced Small
- 500 - Modern (Original Design)
- 600 - Applique
- 700 - Hand/Machine Embroidered
- 800 - Artistic
- 900 - Wall Hangings
- 1000 - Miniatures
- 1100 - Home Accessory – dolls; table runners; bed runners; placemats; napkins; potholders; etc.
- 1200 - Wearable Art – purses; scarves; clothing (quilted, knitted or crochet) and other fiber arts
- 1300 - Youth

Sponsored items are eligible for Viewer's Choice Awards. Sponsored items are subject to space available.



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## **DELIVERY:** Before delivering entries:

- (1) Sew 4-inch sleeve casing (s) to the back of quilt (s) or wall hanging (s). The directions for making a sleeve are attached. **\*\*Note: All Quilts, regardless of size, must have a sleeve attached. Quilts without sleeves will not be accepted.**
- (2) Attach your own fabric label to the lower **left** side of the back of the quilt, including wall hangings & miniatures. For Wearable Art & Home Accessory, attach the label to the inside of each piece. (See example attached)
- (3) Complete the top (shaded portion) of both Claim Checks for each item and bring them with you. This will be your claim check to pick up your item at the end of the show.
- (4) Be sure all items are free of stray threads, animal hair and odors (e.g. pet and smoke).
- (5) If you are sponsoring a non-member, please write your name as exhibitor.
- (6) Delivery of entries will be the same as our last quilt show. We are trying to avoid someone having to store 100+ entry items until the Show. Deliver your quilts on the day of setup (May 14th) at the First United Methodist Church, 6416 Brace Road, Loomis between 3-5pm. If for some reason you are unable to deliver your entries at that time, make arrangements prior to May14th with Carolyn Landers (916) 452-2322.

**PICK UP AFTER OUR SHOW- Bring claim check with you! You will not be allowed to pick up the quilts without it!** Please pick up your items promptly, between the hours of 4:30 P.M -5:00 P.M. on Saturday May16, 2026. Entries will not be released prior to 4:00 P.M. The time to pick up quilt show entries is a small window of time so please be patient with us.

## MAKING A SLEEVE

Cut fabric for sleeve 9" x the width of your quilt.  
**LESS 2 INCHES.**

Fold the 9" ends under twice and sew close to the folded edge.

Fold sleeve in half lengthwise, wrong sides together, and press. This press line will be a guide only.

Open sleeve and fold the edges to the middle press line, wrong sides together. Press these new lines in firmly. They will be your hand sewing lines.








With wrong sides together, sew a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam the length of the sleeve. Begin the seam about  $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the end, backstitch, continue seam to the end, then backstitch. This prevents the tails of thread from hanging out the ends of the sleeve.

Press the seam to one side, taking care not to press over the previous pressed edges. The sleeve will be convex on the side without the seam.

Pin sleeve along pressed edges to the quilt back. The top of the sleeve should be about  $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the top of the quilt. Hand sew, being careful not to stitch through to the quilt front.


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## Quilt Label Placement
